During the second week you'll all be accommodated together at Tisvildeleje Youth Hostel [www.helene.dk](http://www.helene.dk) on the north coast of Zealand close to the Capital City of Denmark — Copenhagen, where we'll show you several parts of Copenhagen such as Tivoli, one of the Top 5 Amusement parks in Europe, Christiania Freetown, Hamlet's Kronborg Castle in Elsinore, The little Mermaid and more, as well as having group activities at the camp and have time with your friends to go to the beach or go shopping.
