Creativity in a changing society

During the weekend you will get to know different aspects of management and creativity through interactive workshops, presentations and activities. You will discover and develop your capabilities in a safe environment under the guidance of experienced managers. In this fully organized three day training course you will gain insight into the many aspects of creativity and leadership.

Main parts of the program:

Reflection & Introduction

After having presented yourself in a playful way, without Powerpoint (!), we will start with the Me-scan. This scan offers a compact, accessible and sharp method to gain insight into the extent to which you use your natural talents. For this, you have completed an online questionnaire prior to the RYLA.

Creativity and deepening

On Saturday we will start with a very special experience that gives you insight into our social behavior based on examples from the animal kingdom. In the afternoon we will be guests at the Parkstad Limburg Theater. There will be the chance to engage in a number of activities which will allow you to completely express your own creativity, expression and talents or perhaps discover new ones. In the evening you're challenged to discover your dance capabilities.

On Sunday morning we will start with a workshop "Bridge Construction". You will be challenged to use your talents and skills together with others, to come to a common solutions. What role do you have in a group process, what are your strengths and weaknesses?
