Water and sanitation

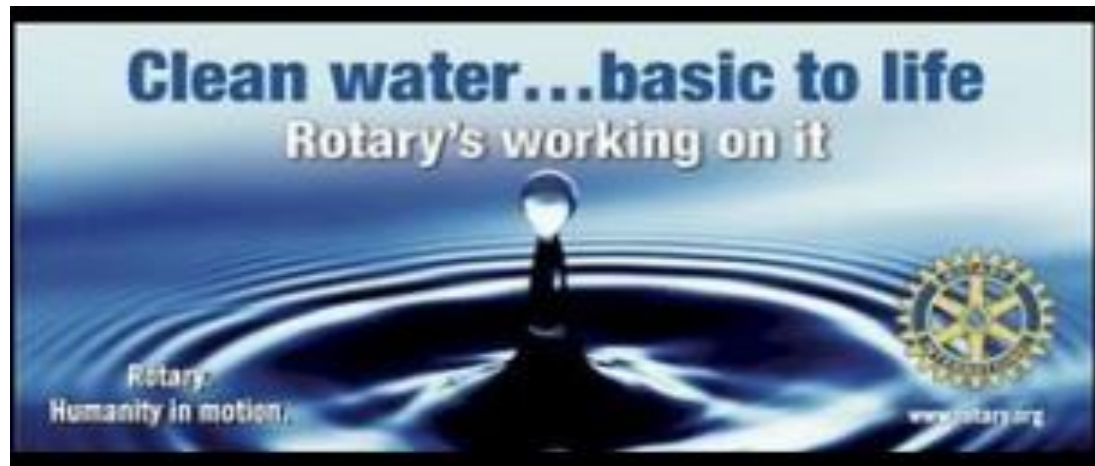
\$ 20 million per year
