Geschiedenis

1917	Uittredend RI President Arch C. Klumph stelde een schenking voor “for the purpose of doing good in the world.”
1928	Hernoemd: The Rotary Foundation
1929	Eerste gift van \$500 aan “the International Society for Crippled Children”
1947	Paul Harris Memorial Fund opgezet t.b.v. Foundation.
1947	Eerste programma van de Foundation;”Fellowships for Advance Study, later bekend als Ambassadorial Scholarships.
1965	Start drie programma’s 1. Group Study Exchange 2. Awards for Technical Training 3. Matching Grants (Grants for Activities in Keeping with the Objective of TRF)
1978	Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) Grants. Eerste project enting van 6 miljoen Filipijnse kinderen tegen polio.
1985	Start Polio de Wereld Uit
1987	De eerste “peace forums” werden gehouden Oprichting Rotary Peace Fellowships.
2013	New district, global, and packaged grants enable Rotarians around the world to respond to the world’s greatest needs.

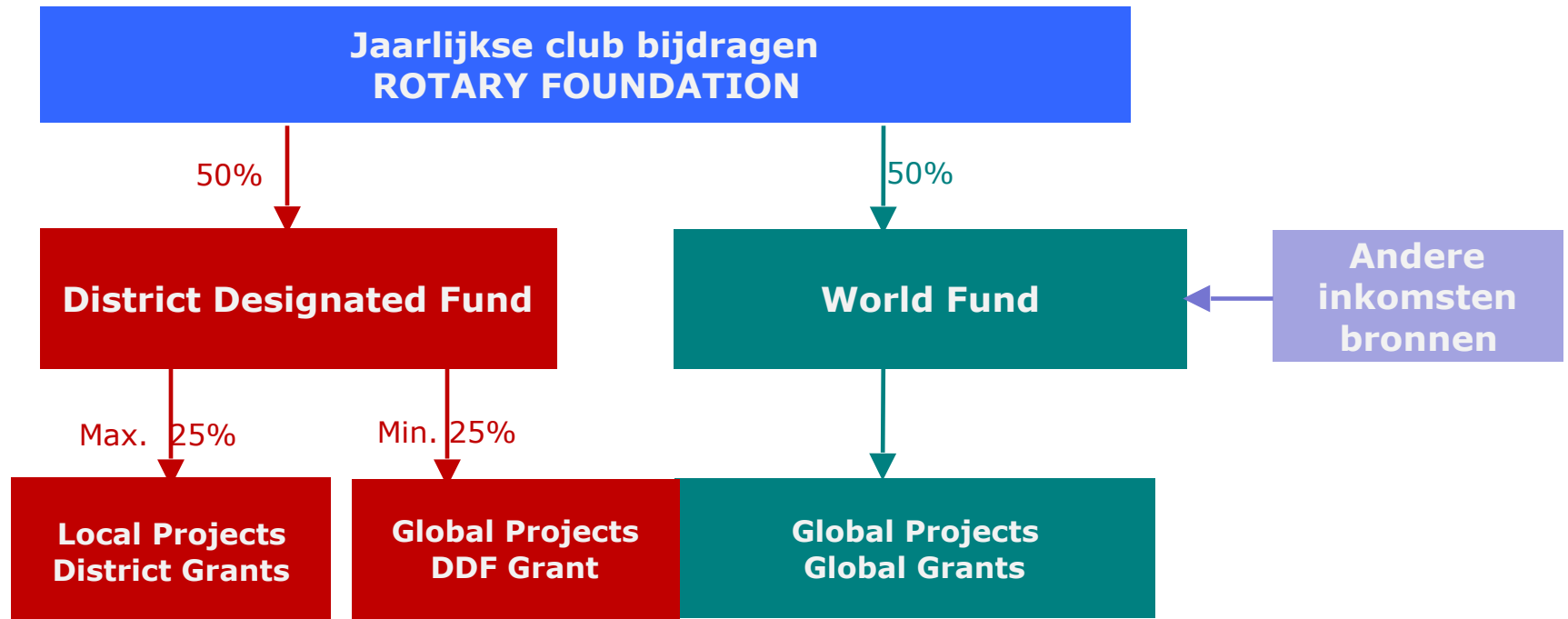

2013-2015: 16 studenten plus 1 Rotaractor (afgestudeerd)
2014-2016: 16 studenten (studerend)
2014-2017: 10 studenten (oktober 2015 aangekomen)

- **D1600 Rotarians host-counselors ondersteunen studenten tijdens hun verblijf**

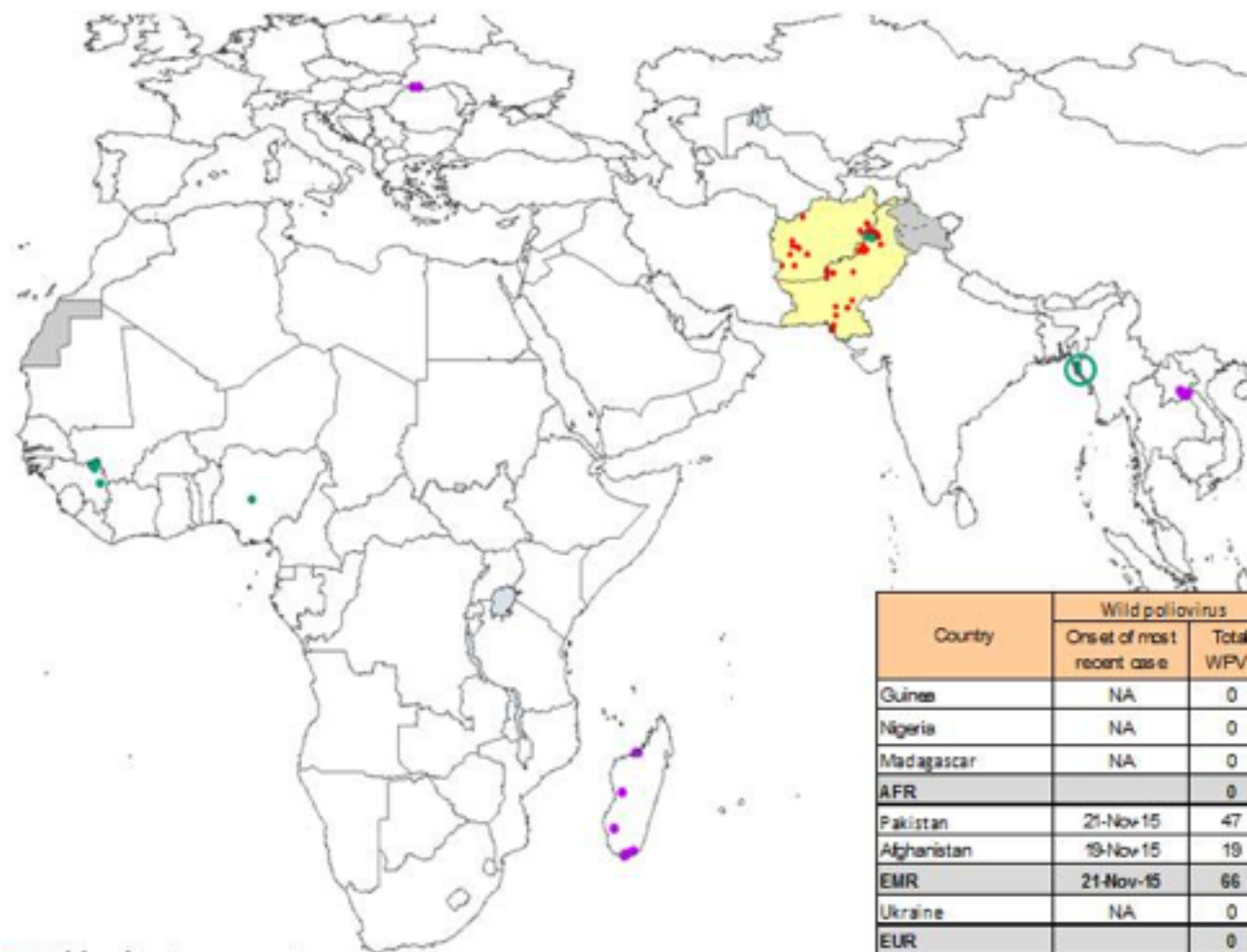


Polio de Wereld Uit

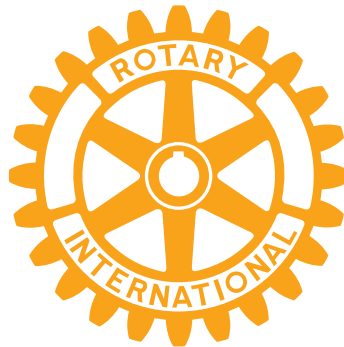
