GENERAL INFORMATION

Weather.

Weather in the Netherlands in summertime can differ by the day. It can be warm and sunny with temperatures up to 25°C or 30°C, but windy and rainy days with temperatures only reaching 17°C are also possible. Let us hope we will have nice weather during your stay, however we recommend that you not only pack your swimming suit and towel, but also a warm sweater and some rain gear.

Currency.

The Netherlands is part of the Euro zone, cash machines are ample available. Other currencies can be changed to euro 's at the airport or any bank.

Meeting at Schiphol.

All participants will be met at Schiphol airport by members of Rotary Club Sassenheim, who will be easily identified by a sign.

Counsellor.
