Arrival	► Saturday 2. July 2011. Preferable between 9 AM and 17 PM. Airport: Schiphol Amsterdam (main airport), Eindhoven airport. Railwayby or bus: Utrecht central station or Deventer central station Rotary Club Epe representative will provide for welcome and transport from airport/railway station.
Aim of Camp	► Introduction to north/east Netherlands and Sailing on the lake "IJsselmeer"
Program	► 1st week - Hosted by the Rotary club "Epe" and visiting several (cultural) attractions in the north/east part of The Netherlands. 2nd week - Hosted by the Rotary club Cuijk and having a sailing experience on the lake "IJsselmeer" or formerly called "Zuiderzee".
Participants	► Totally 17, preferably equal number of girls and boys. Limited to one participants per country.
Age	► 16 - 17 years
Language	► English – good level
Accommodation	► 1st week - Rotarian Epe: staying with host families. 2nd week - Rotarian Cuijk staying with host families during the first two days. Then five days of sailing experience. Hereafter lodging by Rotarians.
All activities will be assisted by Rotarian members or sailing assistants.	
Closing event	► There will be a barbecue and farewell party at the closing of this international meeting between international cultures.
Departure	► Saturday 16. July, 2010. Preferably between 11 AM and 16 PM. Airport : Schiphol Amsterdam (main airport), Eindhoven airport. Railway: Utrecht central station or Deventer central station. Rotary Club Cuijk representative will provide transport to airport/station.
Communication	► Before and during the stay we will provide every participant with a login code for a social media account, like Facebook and/or Twitter. This way you will be able to communicate with other members (and your family during the stay) with messages and photographs.
