At night, the darkness of the woods will turn you into a genuine adventurer.



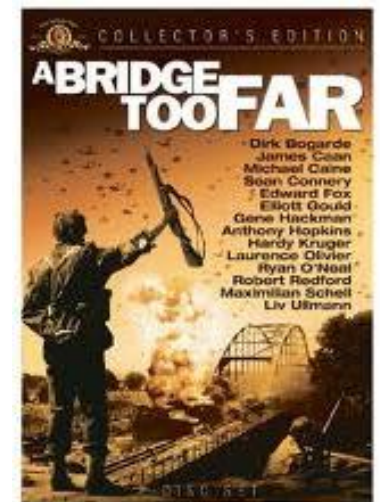
July 3rd
