- Where:** Horst aan de Maas is situated in the Euregio Maastricht - Eindhoven – Düsseldorf (Germany).

- Who:** Boys and girls, 16 -18 years, from different countries. Maximum number is 18 participants.
Main language of the camp is English.
- What:** You will participate in a wide variety of activities which concern culture, environment, familylife, government and leisure. You will experience a different group program/trip every day, with some free time daily.
- Accommodation:** You will stay at Rotary families, preferably with two participants at one family. We appreciate your participation in familylife.
- Costs:** Journey to Netherlands by participants. You will be collected from Amsterdam (Schiphol Airport) or Düsseldorf (Germany).

Zuidlaren-Anloo

29th June till 6th July 2013

A varied program will be offered during the week, e.g. sport activities like cycling and sailing but also cultural activities to a shipyard and a flower auction. Besides that, you will get the opportunity to learn more about the Dutch culture. And of course, there will be sufficient time to explore the environment and get to know each other, which is one of the themes of Rotary. During this week you will stay in Zuidlaren-Anloo in the North of the Netherlands with Dutch families.

Activities day by day

On Saturday we will pick you up and bring you to your host. You will have the Sunday morning off to take some rest and get to know your host family. In the afternoon we will take you for a bike ride through our beautiful landscape.

The next days we offer you a varied program with a visit to a large shipyard called **Royal Bodewes scheepswerf**, and a visit to a typically Dutch industry: the flower auction **FloraHolland**. After these visits we will go **sailing or rowing in one of the lakes** nearby. We will take you to small villages with pre historic mortuary monuments, e.g. the **“hunebedden”**, in a beautiful landscape, with forests, moors and lakes. On Tuesday evening you can join us at our weekly dinner and you can tell us something about yourself and your country.

You will visit the largest city of the North of the Netherlands, **Groningen**, on Wednesday. There you will **visit the Modern Museum of Art**, which is designed by the famous architects Mendini, Philippe Starck and Coop Himmelb(l)au. In the afternoon there will be time to go shopping or to sit on a terrace with many (foreign) students who populate the academic city. Perhaps, when there is enough time, we make a tour with a round sailing boat through the old canals.

Thursday will be a special day because we'll go to the mudflats at the North Coast of the Netherlands. **We will show you one of the most unique and largest coastal wetlands in the world, the Wadden Sea.**

On Friday you prepare a farewell party for yourselves and other Rotarians in the evening. We would like it if you could prepare a meal with your hosts, typical of your own culture, so we can taste something of your home country. You can also do your last shopping in Zuidlaren on Friday, before we say goodbye to each other. The next day, a Rotarian will bring you to the airport or central station (see 'Transport'), depending on where you will depart.

We would like to meet you and we are looking forward to welcome you in Zuidlaren-Anloo!
