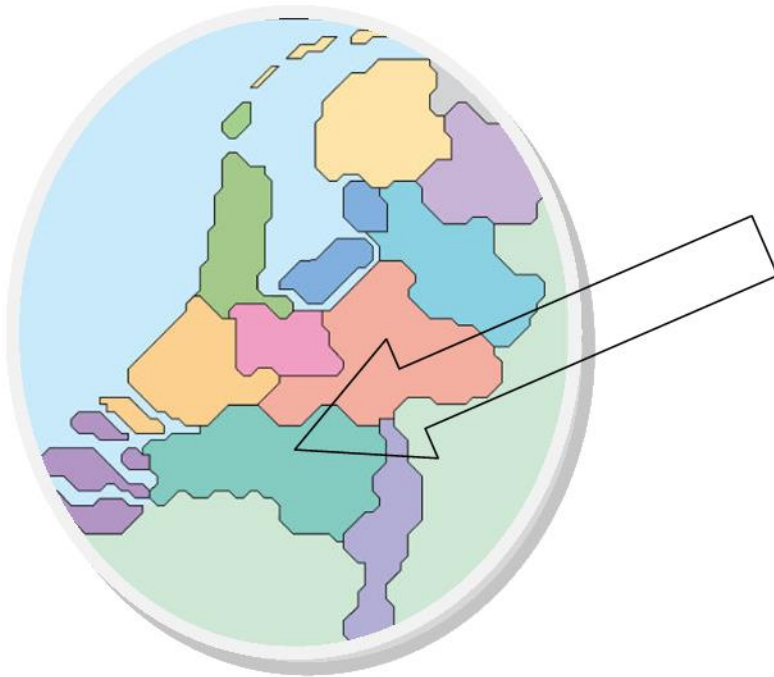
### *June 25th*
