**Name of the Camp:** International Music Camp - Concert tour and sightseeing tour through south-east Bavaria and Austria

**Period :** July, 24<sup>th</sup> – August, 09<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**Number of participants:** 1-2 youngsters per country

**Invitation for:** Young boys or girls aged from 16 to 19 years

**Language:** English

**Program and Accommodation:** The Rotary District 1840 invites young Rotarian or non-Rotarian people to participate in an international music camp to meet other youngsters from different countries and from South Bavaria. During the two weeks the camp members stay in Rotarian families and in youth hostels (during their concert tour). The host clubs are organizing a guided sightseeing program and a concert tour through South Bavaria and Austria.

**Clothing:** Casual clothes plus concert dress (black and white) for the concert tour, swimsuits, hiking shoes

**Costs:** Journey to Bavaria and pocket money must be covered by the participants themselves or their recommending Rotary Club. All other costs are paid by the inviting Club and by the District 1840.

**Insurance:** Every participant has to invest in a Health and Hospital Insurance.

**Arrival at:** Munich airport, meeting point: 'Cafe Meeting Point' (Café / Restaurant Leysieffer, Basement of the " Central area Z " between Module B and C) or at the train station of the inviting Rotary Club.

**Date of arrival:** July, 24<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**Departure at:** Munich airport or at the train station of the inviting Rotary Club

**Date of departure:** August, 09<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**Additional information:** The parents are requested to certify that the applicant is in good health, that he/she is allowed to swim (pre-requisite for participation) and that they agree to medical care if necessity arises.
