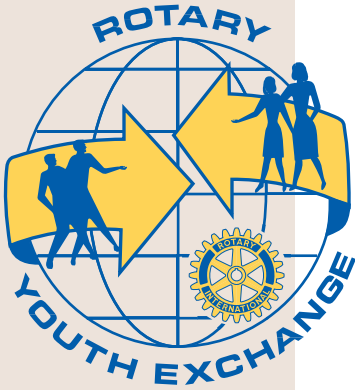

- Program:** Outdoor and culture on the North Swedish coast.
First week will be spent on the YMCA camp at the island Norrbyskär south of Umeå where we will use the range of available facilities including sailing boats, canoes, climbing adventure park. The group will be led by trained youth leaders and will participate in activities and excursions depending on weather.
Second week will be spent with various leisure and cultural activities in the Umeå area, the culture capital of Europe to become in 2014. We will also visit the university and some industry. The participants will be accommodated by families of the Rotary club and together with them they will enjoy all sorts of family activities.
