# Rotary International District 1280 & 1050 Summer Camp 2011

## *Details of Camp*

- Camp/Location** We have again kept the format of our camp to that of an Outdoor Centre Activity located within the Manchester area. The "Petty Pool Outdoor Centre" will appeal to 16/18 year old youngsters, were the accommodation will be in 4 berth Scandinavian Type Chalets, which will only accept a youngster whose height is 1.85 metre or less.
- Dates** **Two weeks** Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July – Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2011
- Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July to Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July the campers will be home hosted in Rotarian's homes in the Manchester area.  
Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July to Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> July – accommodation to be provided at the "Petty Pool Outdoor Centre" in South Manchester.
- Campers** There will be Eighteen campers (9 boys & 9 Girls) from the following countries:- Croatia, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Holland, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania.
- Programme** The first four days will be home hospitality with Rotarians and their families. The remaining days will be at "Petty Pool Outdoor Centre" with activities arranged by Rotary Clubs of District 1280 & 1050. Transport will be provided by the District. Campers may care to bring with them few photographs of their family and home town and perhaps a small musical instrument to provide some entertainment amongst the campers on free evenings
- Cost** There will no charge for staying with Rotarians, or for the Outdoor Centre accommodation and activities. Campers will be responsible for their travel costs to and from Manchester, pocket money and personal expenses
- Clothing** Casual clothes, including a light raincoat, just in case it rains; together with strong footwear for walking / hiking and swimwear etc for sporting activities will be sufficient
- Wardens** Wardens will stay at the Centre and accompany the Campers on the Daily Tours and will contact the Campers prior to the Camp, giving further details of the Camp
- Insurance** It is a essential criteria that all campers must take out a with a suitable travel insurance before arriving to the UK, to cover the eventualities of illness, injury, repatriation, etc. due to unforeseen circumstances.
