

# **Croatian Camp - sea and mountains.**

**Croatian Rotary Clubs are organizing a Summer camp in Summer of 2011.**

**Camp starts in Dubrovnik on Monday August 1st and will last until Sunday August 14th 2011. Participants are supposed to leave Zagreb on the 15th of August .**

## **The Programme of the camp**

**Dubrovnik and surroundings : August 1st - August 5th**

**Flight to Zagreb: August 6th , early in the morning**

**Plitvice Lakes, National Park and Zadar : August 6th**

**Zadar + National Park Kornati islands : August 7th**

**Šibenik + National Park „Waterfalls of Krka „ : August 8th**

**Krasno and mountain Velebit: August 9th**

**Opatija : August 10th – 12th**

**National park Gorski Kotar: August 10th - 13th**

**Return to Zagreb: August 14th in the afternoon**

**Return home : August 15th**

## **When does the Summer camp starts and finish ?**

All participants should arrive in Dubrovnik on the 1st of August . The plane ticket should have Dubrovnik as the final destination ( preferentially through Zagreb because of the fair price and because they fly to Zagreb on the 6th of August and their return flight must be from Zagreb on the 15th of August ) The organizer does not cover the price of flight from Dubrovnik to Zagreb . The last day of our camp is Sunday , August 14th 2011. The return flight is proposed for August 15th from Zagreb.

## **About the Programme**

Dubrovnik is one of the most beautiful cities on the Mediterranean sea. During their stay in Dubrovnik participants will have the opportunity for sightseeing in this old city and getting information about its glory throughout history. Excursions to the neighbouring city of Cavtat, swimming and other activities will be organized.

After 4 days in Dubrovnik participants will fly to Zagreb on the 6th of August (everyone must book the plane tickets for earliest flight around 6 am - those accepted for the camp will be notified of the exact flight time).

Bus will wait for participants at Zagreb airport and will take them to Plitvice Lake (National Park). After visiting Plitvice the trip will continue to Zadar where they will stay for 2 nights. On August the 7th Rotary Club Zadar is organizing a city-sightseeing and boat trip to National Park Kornati Islands. On August the 8th the trip continues by bus to another coastal city – Šibenik. After a short city-sightseeing escorted by members of Rotary Club Šibenik the excursion to National Park „Waterfalls of Krka „ is planned. In the evening the bus will take participants to the small village of Krasno in the region of the National Park Velebit.

Next day 5-6 hours walking tour through the Velebit mountain with a wonderful view on Croatian islands in the North Adriatic will take place. After two nights in the Velebit region the trip continues to one of the most beautiful tourist resorts at the northern Adriatic coast – Opatija, where participants will be hosted by RC Opatija. Sleeping will be organized in another mountain resort – Gorski Kotar (also a National Park) – near the city of Rijeka, where the participants will stay for another 2 days. During these 2 days the walking and climbing tours through the mountains of Gorski Kotar (it is the most beautiful forest region in Croatia) is planned.

On 13th of August participants will return to Zagreb. During their stay in Zagreb the city-sightseeing will be organized. The next day (and the last one) visiting of the castles in the surroundings of Zagreb and to the Museum of Neandertales is organized. In the evening there will be a farewell dinner. The return home is planned for August 15th.

## **Participation fee**

Participation fee is 130 €.

## **Visas**

Citizens of most of the countries do not need a visa for Croatia. During their stay in Croatia participants will be accompanied by a member from one of the Croatian Rotaract Clubs and a professional mountain guide. In Dubrovnik, Zagreb, Šibenik, Zadar , Opatija and Varaždin they will meet members of the local Rotary clubs.

All the meals and lodging, entrance tickets and bus travel costs are provided by the Croatian Youth Exchange Programme.
