Aims:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discovering the one of the smallest of the new countries of Europe with exceptional differences from one place to another • Meeting people and experiencing the nature and culture • Bringing Slovenian Rotarians closer to the Rotarian youth from other countries by offering them hospitality • Education in form of meeting and having the chance to talk to important people from different areas of social life, as from education, politics, religion, economy etc. • Bringing Rotarian youth from different countries together giving them chance to jointly experience new things thus establishing new friendships • Fun and relaxation.
Languages:	English (fluency in everyday conversation is expected)
Place:	Participants will be hosted by approximately 15 Rotary Clubs, from all parts of Slovenia. During the whole stay, there will be a bus on their disposal. The camp will visit most parts of Slovenia.
Lodging:	Clubs will join regionally and provide the joint hosting (Hotels, Hostels) within the region in order to avoid daily moves. We are providing hosting, so there will be a Rotarian host with participants at their daily activities and Camp leader with them at all times.
Costs:	Cost of journey to and from the camp (arrival & departure points) should be covered by the participant. Some pocket money is required. No special participation fee (except insurance) is required. Food and lodging is part of the camp and thus covered by the organizers. Insurance is compulsory (ca. 20 EUR) and will be collected on the spot.

Program:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A visit of a spa & rafting • The Postojna cave and other natural beauties of the country • Cultural visit (painter or sculptor) • A visit to the Slovenian Industry • A visit to a vine cellar (can occur more than once) and possibly winegrowers and vineyards • A cruise on the Slovenian Adriatic coast (subject to weather) • Meeting a representative of the state (member of the government, state secretary or mayor) or major city • A visit to the University or/and Media • Attending the RC Meeting • Tour to Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia and some regional capitals • ...and a lot more <p>The organizers retain the right to adjust the program.</p>
Insurance: <i>Insurance is compulsory!</i>	<p>Participant has to pay around €20,00 on arrival for insurance against:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Illness, accidents, including transport home if this should be necessary. • Lost, theft or damage of the luggage. • Responsibility claims of third parties.

Arrival:	<p>Participants will be collected individually upon their arrival at either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ljubljana (Brnik) international airport (code: LJU) <p>In case the participant is not arriving by plane, he/she should mention that to the organizers to arrange the meeting point.</p>
Participants:	<p>Maximum number of participants: 18 Maximum numbers of participants from each country: 2 girls or boys. Acceptance at organizers' discretion!</p>
Age:	<p>Minimum age: 19 (born before 30th June 1992); Maximum age: 24 (born 1987)</p>

Special remarks:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The participating Slovenian RCs have the right to invite one participant outside the national quota (wild card). The maximum number of participants though shouldn't be exceeded. • Each participant has to contribute his/her impressions (about one page long) of the camp (one day) for the final report in form of the blog to the Sunny Site. Computer equipment and connections will be taken care of. The Sunny Site will be updated daily by blog entries and photos, so parents and friends will be able to have a "live" impressions of the Sunny Side.
