**OUR OFFER:** The paleontological site of Manzati, Barlad, Romania represents the *locus tipicus* for the *Deinotherium gigantisimum* species, discovered in 1890 by the professor Grigore Ștefănescu and at present exposed at the Grigore Antipa Natural Science museum, in Bucharest. The resuming of the research in 2001 has led to professor Gabriel Milan Sava's discovery in 2006 of a rhino's skeleton, which is at present being rebuilt. We wish this camp to bring together the paleontological research activity with relaxation, trips, having fun and cultural exchange of the participants.

**THE EXPERIENCE:** It is not necessary a previous experience of the participants in the field of palaeontology. They will receive all the necessary information at the opening of the camp-opening. Of great importance to the success of your experience will be your willingness to work in a team atmosphere.

**SCHEDULE:** Besides the paleontological research, the schedule contains also: camp-fire, trip (at Moldova's capitale), souvenir shopping, festive dinners, going out (at bars or discos), spare time for socializing and sightseeing. **PARTICIPANT CRITERIA:** 10 teenagers between **16 and 19** years, only one or two participants from each country.

**REGISTRATION FEE:** A non-refundable payment of **200.00 Euro** must be sent to the club until **May 30, 2011**. The money-sending fees are to be paid by each applicant. Therefore, the only necessity is to take pocket money for Museums or other tickets. All fees are non-refundable except for cancellation due to medical reasons. **DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS:** Your country's coordinator must confirm participation of your country by **May 30, 2011** by forwarding your application. At May 30, 2011 any positions not filled may be offered to local youth **16 – 19** years of age.

**VISAS:** You are responsible for all Visas, permissions, authorizations etc. as required by your own countries and by the Romanian government. Please contact a Romanian Consulate for information on visits to Romania.

**INSURANCE:** The participants must be insured against illness, accident and third party damages according to Rotary International recommendations.

**ARRIVAL IN ROMANIA:** Plan your travel to arrive in Bucharest, Romania at "Henri Coanda" Airport between **09:00 hours** and **19:00 hours** on **July 30, 2011**.

**DEPARTURE FROM ROMANIA:** Arrange your travel to depart from the same place between **10:00 hours** and **22:00 hours** on **August 10, 2011**.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Accommodations during the **Paleontological Research Camp 2011**, Manzati, Barlad, ROMANIA, will be with **Rotarian families and student's hostel**, according to camp's schedule and meteorological conditions.
