## The Heart of England - Past and Present 6<sup>th</sup> July to 15<sup>th</sup> July



Rotary district 1060 covers the West Midlands and Warwickshire areas of England. The West Midlands was the manufacturing centre of England and still is home to many world brands not least of which are Jaguar Land Rover and Cadburys.

In Warwickshire are the towns of Stratford on Avon, the birthplace of William Shakespeare and of Warwick, the location of the best preserved medieval castle in England.



We are currently creating a programme of interesting visits to tourist attractions and other places of interest. In addition there will be hospitality offered by the Coventry Rotary Clubs.

The camp will be limited to 8 persons (4 Male and 4 Female), no more than 1 person from a country. Places will be offered, at the discretion of the camp organisers, but in principle on a 'first come' basis, however preference will be given to those who have not been to England before and to 'first time' Rotary campers.
