The two rotary clubs in Nordborg and in Graasten located in the southern part of Denmark invite young people to participate in a summer camp in the period from Sunday July 1st to Saturday July 14th 2012. The camp will get through for a group of 20 participants preferably with a maximum of 2 people from each country. All nationalities (except Danish) are eligible for participation.

Application is open for young females and males between 16 and 19 years of age. The camp language will be English, so applicants are expected to be reasonably able to understand and speak English.

To qualify you shall be sponsored by a rotary club in your own country. The camp is open both to relatives of rotarians as well as to applicants without rotary affiliation.
