Since then Roskilde has succeeded in preserving the atmosphere of history, by keeping old traditions alive in an open air museum and sailing in Viking ships. With base camp at the dormitory of a technical school, with some overnight stays in shelter, tents or maybe even open air you will experience yourself, through activities together with adult Rotarians, how this life was, is, and will be in the future.

From 7th to 22nd July 2012, including two week-ends spent at home stays with Rotary families, Roskilde South Rotary Club invites 20 young people to participate in this camp. With a preferred age of 16 – 18 years, we aim at equal participation of boys and girls.

The programme includes biking, Viking life and sailing, cultural events, go-cart racing, beach day and sports, study tours to royal residences in North Zealand and the City of Copenhagen including the Parliament and the Tivoli Gardens as well as an outdoor survival exercise. We conclude the programme with a Rotary grill party.
