Requirements:	Preferably, the participants have some experience in mountaineering. Beginners are also welcome, provided they are active in sports. Applicants must confirm that they are in excellent physical condition and are well trained.								
Language:	French, German and/or English								
Accommodation:	Mountain Cabin								
Program:	Two adventurous weeks in the Valais region of the Swiss Alps. Introduction to alpine environment and climbing on rock and ice for beginners and medium level. Acquaintance with flora, fauna and geology. The camp is supervised and led by professional mountain guides. Insurance:	All foreign participants will be insured by the organiser against illness, accident third party damages and all other risks according to Rotary International recommendations. The Swiss participants need to subscribe at their own expenses an insurance at Air Glaciers.								
Total costs for participants:	Participants will need to cover their travel costs to Martigny and back and pocket money. A fee of € 990.- to the foreign participants and CHF 1'200.- to the participants from Switzerland is charged by the organising club prior to arrival which will cover the cost for mountain guides, food as well as for transportation during the camp activities.
