Rotary District 1060 covers parts of Worcestershire, West Midlands and Warwickshire areas of England. The area was the manufacturing centre of England and still is home to many global brands not least of which are Jaguar Land Rover and Cadbury.

Among the many towns with rich histories are Stratford on Avon, the birthplace of William Shakespeare and Warwick, the location of the best preserved medieval castle in England.



We are currently creating a programme to discover the industrial heritage of the area including visits to tourist attractions and other places of interest. In addition there will be some fun activities and hospitality by the organising Rotary Clubs.

The camp will be limited to 10 persons (Male and Female), with no more than 1 person from a country. Places will be offered, at the discretion of the camp organisers, but in principle on a 'first come' basis, however preference will be given to those who have not been to England before and to 'first time' Rotary campers.

**Age Range:** 18 to 21 years of age at start date of camp. You must be able to swim.

**Accommodation:** Hotel accommodation - 2 or 3 students per room.

**Language:** English

**Cost:** Your travel to and from Birmingham Airport (BHX), visa (if required), suitable insurance, pocket money and camp fee of £200 (approx. €230) - Camp fee becomes due immediately upon offer of a place.
