### **Condition:**

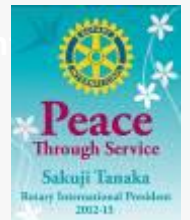
1. Be cheerful & open minded to see various cultures & meet new friends.

**Lodging:** Youth hostels + Host family

**Participants:** Max. 30 participants (2 girls & 2 boys from each district preferred)

Acceptances will be granted on “first come first served” basis subject to district and gender limitations above. (If the applicants are less than 25 persons, we reserve the right to cancel the camp activity.)



**Costs:** A participation fee of USD900.- will be charged. And the participants pay for their own trip to/from Taiwan. We will further advise the participants to bring their own pocket money.

**Insurance:** All participants MUST be insured on their costs against illness, accident, third party damages and all other risks, inclusive of repatriation coverage, according to Rotary International recommendations. [www.culturalinsurance.com](http://www.culturalinsurance.com)

**Clothing:** Casual and sportswear, bathing suit, beachwear, sneakers, sandals, jacket, hometown costume. There will be opportunity for the exchange of Rotary Club flags dressing your own country costume at the farewell party. In the program, you'll spend 2 days doing the meditation in a temple and in this occasion neither tank top nor sandal will be allowed.

**Program:** A combination of sight seeing, nature, culture, outdoor activities and socializing. 10 days round-the-island trip for the visit to lakes, mountains, beach, aboriginal tribe, spectacular marbles valley, traditional temples, special highlights and for the experience of DIY on various handicrafts and of some exciting paintball game..... A more detailed program will be sent to the participants in June 2013. The camp is basically a **non-smoking** camp.

**Arrival:** On Friday 12th Jul. 2013 at Taoyuan International Airport, Taiwan.

You'll be picked up at the airport by your host family. (The names of some cities in China are very similar to the airport mentioned above. Please make sure your flight is booked to **Taiwan, NOT China.**)
