General overview

Name/theme of the Camp:

Bicycle Adventure Camp

We offer a 2 week bicycle tour through Lower Saxony, one of the states in northern Germany. This includes visits to the cities of Bremen and Hamburg and other activities like canoing, hiking through tidelands at the North Sea, tree climbing park, etc. Daily distance on the bicycle will range between 40-90 kilometers on mostly flat terrain. Nevertheless, it will be a sportive challenge and requires good physical fitness.

Travel cost and fees:	Participants are responsible for travel expenses back and forth from their respective homes to the Airport Hannover , Germany. We will charge 200€ per person to cover expenses on tour, such as accommodations, food, transportation, bike rental, and various fees . It is recommended to bring approximately another 320 € as additional personal allowance for beverages etc. (pocket money).
